MINUTES

Twenty-nine Friends gathered via videoteleconference.

The meeting began with worship at 7 pm.

Phoebe opened worship with a reading from SEYM's Faith and Practice:

Friends gather in meeting for worship with concern for business at yearly meting and interim business meetings not as instructed delegates but as individuals guided by the Spirit at that time and place. In so gathering, members may experience the tensions that may be created by discernment among the dictates of individual conscience, the sense of their home meeting, and the best interests of the whole. Implicit is Friends' understanding that we seek to discern the leadings of God throughout our sessions.

The meeting settled back into the silence.

The agenda was reviewed. Roll Call was taken after the agenda review and Ed Lesnick advised that the Golden Isles Worship Group had been laid down because the convenor, Lisa Perrin, cannot travel to Florida. The Gathering Committee will report at the end of the agenda. The ad hoc FGC Gathering request committee will report after Worship and Ministry. The SEYM secretary will report after the Gathering Committee, followed by the Half Yearly Meeting Committee.

Liz Dykes called the roll of Monthly Meetings and Worship Groups. Friends introduced themselves.

Numbered Minutes from the Fall Interim Business Meeting and the Called Executive Committee Meeting (both attached) were reviewed. Friends accepted the minutes.

Ed Lesnick reported for the Nominating Committee (attached).

Nominating Committee is looking to the Naming Committee to name additional members. Phoebe will appoint the Naming Committee this weekend.

Joel Cook presented the Treasurer's Report (attached). Apportionments are coming in more slowly than they have in past years. This is of some concern. It is suggested that we look into getting PPP (Paycheck Protection Program) funds. There has been only one request to the

COVID-19 relief fund, for \$500, so there is a balance in that program is \$14,500. The report was accepted.

Peter Schmidt reported that the Finance Committee usually reports after meeting on Saturday morning, so he will give a report on Saturday afternoon. The committee will consider recommending applying for PPP funds. If such a request were to be recommended and approved by IBM, the Yearly Meeting clerk would sign as the presiding officer.

Phoebe reported that she thinks it is time to have an ad hoc Committee on Apportionments to look at all the minutes and clarify the procedure for calculating apportionments. We will consider this at the end of the agenda if there is time, or it will happen at EC at yearly meeting sessions

Bill Carlie reported on the ad hoc FGC Gathering Request Committee.

EC2021-01 Executive Committee unites with the recommendation of the ad hoc FGC Gathering Request Committee that we decline the invitation to host the 2022 Gathering. SEYM is grateful to be asked, and would consider hosting or co-hosting in the future, perhaps at a locale nearer our meetings. APPROVED

Nancy Triscritti presented the Worship and Ministry Report. She thanked Vicki and Susan for help with the technical portion of the Michener Lecture.

Cecilia Yocum reported for the Youth Committee. Attendance has been sparse. She is anxious for new members to revive the committee. They will be looking at activities for yearly meeting sessions on Saturday. Families would like to have a camping weekend in the summer; there are questions about insurance.

Susan Taylor reported for the Committee for Ministry on Racism, giving the joint report from CMOR and the Youth Committee (see <u>Documents in Advance</u>). She stressed that meetings are invited to join together with CMOR to remove White Supremacy from SEYM and its meetings. Friends accepted the report.

Phil Stone reported to the Peace and Social Concerns Committee report (see Documents in Advance). Committee attendance has been increasing. They have had good discussions about the relationship of this committee to other committees and groups within the Yearly Meeting who are also working on issues of climate change and racism, this remains an ongoing conversation which Phil encourages Friends to think about. Friends accepted the report.

Vicki Carlie reported for the Gathering Committee. LEC has agreed to move our deposit to 2022. This is good news. The committee is working on a draft schedule. It will be more compressed than last year. Probably eight days over two weeks, mostly evenings and Saturdays. Friends accepted the report

Susan Wade made the secretary's report. There are 80-85 sign ups for the Michener Lecture. There may be a need to upgrade our Zoom account for a month to record the lecture and store it. Friends accepted the report and thanked Susan for her work

Jean Larson read the Half Yearly Meeting report. Jerry Knutson reported that Half Yearly Meeting will be an in person event. The camp is reserved and Friends should put HYM on their calendars for Thanksgiving weekend.

Beverly Ward presented a report from the Earthcare Secretary. She is called to her work because of her desire to see the beloved community, but recent events have shaken that vision. Friends accepted the report with thanks.

Phoebe asked for volunteers for a Naming Committee to name the Nominating Committee. Peter Schmidt is willing to serve. One or two additional Friends will be sought.

A CAPP coordinator is needed. Friends are asked to think about someone who could serve.

Liz Dykes read back the numbered minute. The minute was accepted.

The meeting closed with worship.

SEYM Treasurer's Report Documents in Advance Winter Interim Business Meeting 16 First Month 2021

Report for end of First Half of Fiscal Year 2020-21 (June 1 thru Nov. 30, 2020) All values are rounded to the nearest dollar.

SEYM Total Cash Flow not including Trustees

The overall cash flow of the Yearly Meeting (excluding the Trustees' accounts) for this period yielded a net loss (excluding unrealized capital gains of \$ 1,024 on investments for the Publications program) of \$11,819 including \$650 restricted donations for the Field Secretary for Earthcare program. This resulted from an SEYM total real income of \$30,610 against total expenses of \$42,428.

SEYM General Fund for Administration - Cash Flow and Budget Performance

At the end of this period, the General Fund (the operations fund for which we approved a balanced budget of \$86,410 in our 2020 Yearly Meeting sessions) showed a net loss of \$3,978. This resulted from General Fund total income of \$21,040 (27% of budget) against expenses of \$28,249 (33% of budget).

Budget Support Apportionments & Contributions Received

During this period, in response to the annual request for support of the approved General Fund Budget (the Apportionments), contributions received from the Monthly Meetings and Worship Groups totaled \$20,215, or 26% of the year's budgeted request of \$76,590.

Sixteen Monthly Meetings and Seven Worship Groups were included in the Apportionment request this fiscal year. So far, three (3) have contributed between three-quarters and their entire requested amount, two (2) have contributed one-half to three guarters, four (4) have contributed ten percent to half, and fifteen (15) have not contributed anything.

The unrestricted individual donations received toward the Budget during this period totaled \$825 approximately 41% of the \$2,000 budgeted amount.

Cash Flow Results for Programs

The annual programs for this fiscal year are in progress; cash flow is incomplete.

The Publications program during this period had a net loss of \$1,587, excluding unrealized capital gains of \$1,024 on investments for the program.

The SEYM Field Secretary for Earthcare program during this period received \$650 in donations and had expenses of \$8,957, yielding a net loss of \$8,307.

The Net Worth of the combined Yearly Meeting and its Trustees at the end of this period was \$562,480, an increase of \$21,605 including \$30,578 in unrealized capital gains since the beginning of the fiscal year.
